During Hybrid and Distance Learning, when there is a need for a combination class at the elementary level, the following provisions will apply; in addition to the current language in Article 10 of the CBA where applicable.

- 1. Unit members at the school site will be notified in a timely manner that combination class(es) are being created, and will have an opportunity to volunteer for the position(s).
- 2. Every reasonable attempt will be used to ensure that only unit members who are permanent and on Process B are eligible for combination class assignments.
- 3. A volunteer may select a combination class at any grade-level. An involuntary assignment to a combination class may only be made within one grade-level of their current assignment per Article 8.1.2.5. (For example, a teacher at second grade may be assigned a 1/2 or a 2/3 combination class.)
- 4. Unit members who volunteer or are assigned to a combination class (in grades TK-5) shall receive a \$3000.00 stipend for each trimester, not to exceed three trimesters) of teaching a combination class during Distance Learning. Stipends will be paid on the November, March and June payroll.

This MOU shall sunset at the end of 20-21 school year. The parties agree to meet to discuss ways to avoid combo classes.
